

Students Satisfaction Survey on Teaching Learning Process

1. According to the survey 49.5% of the students agreed that 85% to 100% of the syllabus is covered in the class, 26.3 % agreed that 72% to 84% of the syllabus is covered in the class, 15% agreed that 55% to 69% of the syllabus is covered in the class and 9.1 % agreed that 30to 54% of the syllabus is covered in the class.
2. 59.3% of the students agreed that the teachers prepared thoroughly for the class followed by 38.5% satisfactorily.
3. 62.5% of the students agreed that the teachers are always able to communicate effectively followed by 25.5% to be sometimes effective and 10.5% to be just satisfactorily.
4. 40% of the students described teachers approach to teaching to be excellent, 40% described it to be very good followed by 20% to be good.
5. 55.4% of the students responded that internal evaluation process by the teachers as always fair, followed by 33.4% as usually fair and 8.7% as sometimes unfair.
6. 50% of the students responded that the performance in assignments is every time discussed with them followed by 30.5% as usually discussed and 13% as sometimes discussed.
7. Almost 50% of the students responded that the institution regularly take active interest in promoting internship, field visit, opportunities etc. followed by 25% as often and 20% as sometimes.
8. 54.5% of the students responded that the teaching and mentoring process in our institution facilitate significantly in cognitive, social and emotional growth followed by 26% as very well and 15.5% as moderately.
9. 51.7% of the students strongly agreed that the institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow followed by 32% agreed and 14% as neutral for the same.
10. 56.3% of the students agreed that the teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes followed by 31% as usually and rest as occasionally.
11. 44.2% of the students agreed that **every time** mentor does a necessary follow-ups with an assigned task to you followed by 41% **usually** and 10% **occasionally**.
12. Almost 60% of the students agreed that the teachers **everytime** illustrate the concepts through examples and applications followed by 31.5% as **usually** and rest as **occasionally**.

13. 53% of the students agreed that the teacher **fully** identify your strength and encourage you with providing right level of challenges followed by 33% as **reasonably** identify and rest as **partially** identify.
14. Almost 51% of the students responded that **every time** the teacher are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them followed by 29% as **usually** identify and 13% as **occasionally** identify and rest as **rarely** identify.
15. 61% of the students showed neutral response followed by 28% agreed and rest disagreed that the institution makes efforts to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.
16. 44.4% of the students agreed **to a great extent** that the institute/teachers use student centric methods such as experimental learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences followed by 37.2% **moderate** and rest as **somewhat** in response to the same statement.
17. 56% of the students strongly agreed followed by 28% agreed, 12.5% Neutral, 2.8% disagree and 1% strongly disagreed that the teachers encourage you to participate in extra circular activities.
18. 43% of the students responded that the effort made by the institute/teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work followed by about 40% as **moderate**, 10% as **somewhat** and about 6% as **very little** in response to the same statement.
19. 29% of the students responded that 70 to 89% of the teacher use ICT tools followed by 23% of the students who agreed that 50 to 69% of the teacher use ICT tools, 18.6% of students responded that below 29% of the teacher use ICT tools, and 14% responded that 30 to 49% of the teacher use ICT tool while teaching.
20. 47.4% of the students agreed that the overall quality of teaching-learning process in our institute is very good followed by 20% to strongly disagreed, 19% were neutral, 11% strongly disagreed and 2% disagreed in response to the same statement.
21. Majority of the students had no suggestions to make because they found overall teaching learning-experience in the institution to be very good.
But here are a few suggestions by some of the students.
 - Interaction in the class should not be limited to only a few intelligent students but with the whole class and there should be two-way interaction.
 - Teachers should give more examples for better understanding of the concept.

- More emphasis should be given on soft skills and employability skills.
- Time table should be such that there is a break in between.
- Teachers should use more innovative methods like group discussions and videos etc. for the better understanding of the concepts.
- Students also want more use of PPTs for teaching.
- Teachers should be friendly.
- Students should be allowed to attend conferences etc.
- Research should be promoted

UG Part-A

1. 45% students are strongly agreed that the teachers are punctual and regular while 49% are agreed only 6% are neutral.
2. Around 42% of the students strongly agreed that the teachers come well prepared for the lecture while 46% agreed with the statement and 10% of the students were neutral.
3. 38% of the students felt that the teachers are able to communicate well with the students while 52% agreed to the statement and 9% were neutral.
4. 36% of the students strongly agreed that the teacher encourage them for participation and discussion in the class, approximately 50% of the students agreed to this and 10% did not give any response i.e. they were neutral.
5. About 30% of the respondents strongly agreed that the teacher do necessary follow up with an assigned task. More than 50% of the respondent agreed to this while 12% are neutral and 3% disagreed to this point.
6. 34% of the student strongly agreed that the teacher identify their strengths are encourage them in providing right level of challenges. 45% agreed to this, 15% students were neutral and 7% of the students disagreed with the statement.
7. 25% of the respondents strongly agreed that the teachers are able to identify their weaknesses and help to overcome them. More than 50% of the students agreed to this, 13% were neutral and 6% disagreed with the statement.
8. 39% of the respondents strongly agreed that the teachers are friendly and helpful to them. 45% agreed, 12% were neutral and 5% disagreed with the statement.
9. 27% of the respondents strongly agreed regarding the use of modern teaching aids by the teachers. 42% agreed to the statement while 19% were neutral and remaining students disagreed to the same.

10. 50% of the students strongly agreed that the teachers give relevant examples in their lectures while 37% of the students agreed to this and 13% were neutral.
11. 38% of the respondents strongly agreed that the teachers are available and accessible after lecture timings, more than half of the respondents agreed and 9% students were neutral on this point.
12. More than half the students agreed that the teacher give sufficient time for practice and revision, 28% students strongly opined to the statement while 15% were neutral and 5% did not agreed with the statement.
13. 46% of the respondents opined that the tests are evaluated and discussed in the class while 30% of the respondents strongly opined, 18% were neutral and only a few students did not agree.
14. About 50% of the respondents opined that the evaluation process is fair and unbiased while 50% strongly agreed to the statement.
15. More than 50% of the respondents agreed that the regular and timely feedback is given on their performance by the teachers. 30% of the students strongly agreed, 15% were neutral and only 5% disagreed with the statement.
16. All the respondents strongly agreed with the statement that the teachers maintained attendance record.
17. More than 80% of the respondents strongly agreed with the statement that they received adequate recognition for their accomplishment while others were neutral to the statement.
18. More than 50% of the respondents agreed that the courses studied by them have enhances their knowledge, skills and capabilities. 34% strongly favor the statement while others were neutral to the same.
19. Most of the respondents felt that the efforts are made by the teachers to inculcate softs skills life skills and employability skills to make them ready for the world of work while some students were neutral.
20. Majority of the respondents agreed that the teacher encourage them to participate in extra curricular activities.
21. More than 50% of the respondents agreed that teachers use student centric method such as experimental learning, participative learning, peer learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences while others strongly agreed in response to the same.
22. Majority of the respondents opined that the overall quality of teaching learning process in our institution is very good.

UG-Part B

1. 57% of the respondents strongly agreed that the college campus is a highly protective and safe place for them and 39% also agreed to the same. Only a few respondents were neutral to the same.
2. 32% of the respondents strongly agreed that there is diversity and racial harmony in the college campus and majority of the students' response to the same was neutral.
3. 40% of the respondents strongly agreed to the statement that the classroom space is adequate to them. Others were neutral to the same.
4. Majority of the students agreed that their class size is appropriate while 41% of the students were neutral to the same.
5. Most of the students' response to the statement that the variety of courses offered is adequate and also academically demanding was neutral and less than 50% strongly agreed to it.
6. More than 50% of the respondents were neutral in response to the statement that their tutors and advisors are available when needed and 35% of the students strongly agreed to it.
7. Less than 50% of the students agreed that the college office staff is cooperative and helpful and others were neutral to the same.
8. 36% of the respondents agreed that the library staff in the college is cooperative, 43% students showed neutral response and rest of them disagreed with the same.
9. 50% of the respondents agreed that the online educational resources were available and accessible in the library while 28% strongly agreed and rest of them were neutrals.
10. Approximately 50% of the students agreed that the prescribed books or the reading material is available in the college library 26% strongly agreed and rest were neutral.
11. 27% of the respondents agreed that the equipment in the labs is in good working condition and majority of the students were neutral to the statement.
12. 26% of the respondents strongly agreed, 44% agreed and 15% were neutral to the statement that common room is available in the college.
13. About 23% of the respondents strongly agreed, 39% agreed and rest gave a neutral response to the statement that the washrooms and toilets in the college are clean and properly maintained.

14. About 80% of the students agreed and about 20% were neutral to the statement that their classrooms are clean and properly maintained.
15. 30% of the respondents strongly agreed and rest of them agreed to the statement that the clean drinking water is available in the campus.
16. 28% of the respondents strongly agreed, while rest of them give a neutral response to the statement that the building/class rooms are accessible to the disabled persons.
17. 31% of the respondents strongly agreed and rest of them agreed that the power supply in their college is adequate.
18. 34% of the respondents strongly agreed, 56% agreed and rest of them gave a neutral response to the statement that their campus is green and eco friendly.
19. About 50% of the respondents strongly agreed and rest of them agreed that their problems are solved well in time.
20. Around 25% of the respondents strongly agreed and rest of them were neutral to the statement that carrier counseling is satisfactory in the college.
21. Around 25% of the respondents strongly agreed and rest of them were neutral to the statement that personality development and personnel grooming is taken care of in the college.
22. 48% of the respondents strongly agreed, 32% agreed and rest of them were neutral to the statement that financial aid services is available to the economically weaker student.
23. 33% of the students strongly agreed and rest of them agreed that the fee waiver/discount is given to the meritorious students.
24. 30% of the respondents agreed and rest of them were neutral to the statement that hygienic food/snack/meals are available in the college canteen.
25. 30% of the respondents strongly agreed and rest of them agreed that the transportation facilities are satisfactory.

PG Part-A

1. More than 95 % of the respondent strongly agreed that entire syllabus is completed in time while a few gave neutral response.
2. Approximately all the respondent strongly agreed about the punctuality and regularity of the teachers.
3. More than 60 % of the students strongly agreed followed by about 40 % who agreed that the teachers come well prepared for the class.

4. A large majority of respondent strongly agreed that the teachers can communicate well in class.
5. 35% of the respondent strongly agreed, more than 50% agreed while 15% gave the neutral response to the statement that the teachers encourage them for participation and discussion.
6. More than 90% of the respondent opined that the teachers do necessary follow up with an assigned task to them while a few gave the neutral response.
7. More than 50% of the students highly agreed, 25% agreed and rest of them gave the neutral response to the statement that the teachers identify their strength and encourage them with providing right level of challenges.
8. About 70% of the students strongly agreed that the teachers are able to identify their weaknesses and help overcome them while 20% were neutral and 10% disagreed with the statement.
9. Majority of the respondent highly agreed while a few agreed that the teachers' attitude towards students is friendly and helpful.
10. 75% of the respondent highly agreed, 18% agreed while a few gave the neutral response and some disagreed that their teachers use modern teaching aids.
11. A large majority of the students strongly agreed while a few agreed that the teachers illustrate the concept through examples and applications.
12. More than 90% of the students highly agreed and rest of them agreed that the teachers are available and accessible after the lecture timings.
13. About 50% of the respondents think that the teachers can't give sufficient time for revision and practice while rest of the students agreed that practice and revision is appropriate.
14. 20% of the respondents strongly agreed, 50% agreed followed by 20% neutral and rest disagreed that the tests are evaluated and discussed in class.
15. A large majority of the respondents strongly agreed followed by a few who agreed that the evaluation process is fair and unbiased.
16. 70% of the respondent agreed followed by 5% who agreed and 25% who were neutral to the statement that regular and timely feedback is given on their performance.
17. All the respondents agreed that the attendance record is maintained by the teachers.

18. About 50% of the respondents agreed that they receive adequate recognition for their accomplishment, 30% respondents strongly followed the same while remaining were neutral.
19. More than 95% of the respondents agreed that the course studied by them have enhanced their knowledge as well as their skills and capabilities.
20. More than 95% of the respondents agreed that the efforts made by the teachers to inculcate the soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make them ready for the world of work while a few were neutral in response to the same.
21. Approximately 90% of the respondents agreed that the teachers encourage them to participate in extracurricular activities while 10% were neutral in response to the same.
22. Approximately 75% of the respondents agreed that the teachers use student centric method such as experimental learning, participative learning, peer learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences while others were neutral.
23. Majority of the respondents opined that the overall quality of teaching learning process in their institution is very good.
