IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- Parents & candidates are advised to study the prospectus carefully before applying for the admission. 1.
- 2. All admissions are provisional and is subject to approval of the university.
- 3. The students will not be allowed to opt for a subject if the number of students is less than ten.
- 4. A student must clear Mid-Semester Tests to become eligible for university examinations.
- 5. To qualify for admission in 2nd year of the course, the candidate must have passed 50% of total papers of the two semesters of the 1st year. Similarly, to qualify for admission in 3rd year of the course, the candidate must have passed 50% of total papers of four semesters of the earlier two years.
- All the information regarding activities of the students will be displayed on the notice board in the form of notices and 6. circulars. It is the duty of students to read the notice board daily. No excuse of not seeing the notice or absence will be entertained. No separate information will be sent to the parents (in case offline studies).
- 7. Students are required to bring their I-card daily along with them.
- 8. Ragging is strictly prohibited as per orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India Ref. No. SLP No. 24295/2004. i) The students involved in ragging may be expelled from the institution.
 - As per the directions of Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Higher Education-Govt. ii) of India- Any student involved in ragging may be expelled from the institution and at the same time FIR with the local police may be lodged and criminal case may be registered against her.
 - iii) Anti-ragging undertaking must be filled online at: www.antiragging.in and submit the undertaking of student & parents through email to their respective tutors before session begins.
 - With ref. to D.O. No. F.I/15//2015(ARC) dated 18.3.2016, a nationwide toll free anti-ragging helpline 1800iv) 180-5522 in twelve languages has been established.
- Our College provides fee concession to SINGLE GIRL CHILD Category. This is one of the best practices of our 9. college.
- 10. As per the instructions of Deputy Commissioner, all the eligible students must have their voter cards.
- 11. As per the directions of Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court, the Asstt. Supdt. of Police, Bathinda has directed the heads of all educational institutions to make it mandatory for the students to wear helmet while driving two-wheelers. The students violating this traffic rule will be severely dealt with under Motor-Vehicle Act. 1989. Bathinda City Traffic department has issued instructions for two wheeler riders which are prohibition of underage driving, driving without helmet & speeding.
- 12. Any student facing any kind of harassment can write her complaint and drop it in to the complaint box which has been put up by Distt. Police authorities near the entrance of the college. In case of emergency, they can also call on the following helpline numbers for women. 0164-2240935, 98759-18028, 75080-18100.
- 13. In case the no. of students is less than ten from one particular route, they will not get any transportation facility.

LIBRARY

A well-equipped air-conditioned library is a valuable aid to young scholars. About 31046 books, 36 encyclopedias of different subjects, 20 magazines & Journals, 10 newspapers are at the disposal of the students. The general library with its open as well as closed stock system and spacious reading room, provides an atmosphere conducive to the excitement of mental discovery. Students are encouraged to become sagacious users of the library which is a temple of learning for them. The college library is computerised where the software *e-granthalaya* enables maintenance and access of stock, issuance and return of books. E-learning resources provided by our college i.e. INFLIBNET (Information and library Network) and DELNET (Developing Library Network) through college component of e-shodhsindu consortium with access to 6000 + Journals 1,99,500 + e-books under N-List and 6,00,000 e-books through NDL. The college provides facility of book bank to the students. Books are issued to the students for a specific period of time.





HOSTEL

A gracious well furnished fully air conditioned residence has capacity to accommodate about 300 students. With its spacious common room, visitors' lounge, facilities for recreation, laundry (washing machine), electric geyser and solar water heater (24-hour hot water supply), digital generators (24-hour electricity supply) comfortable and fully furnished living quarters, fine cuisine and safe drinking water, the hostel is nothing but "Home Away From Home". It is under the care of the warden and her staff who help the students to settle down quickly and to be a part of the lively hostel community. Complete safety and security inside the hostel and campus is ensured by the security staff on duty. Parents can meet their wards in the visitors' room with the permission of warden. Students seeking admission to the hostel must apply for it on a separate application form available with hostel prospectus from the office, after getting admission to the college. The completed form must be submitted to the office by the date specified on the college notice board. A copy of the latest mark sheet and a certificate of physical fitness should be attached with the application form. The students must be accompanied by their parents or a responsible guardian at the time of admission. Admission to the college hostel will be on first come first serve basis.



CAFETERIA

New Cafeteria is in the college campus for the refreshment of students and teachers. Cafeteria has a very attractive and joyful atmosphere. Come and Enjoy!



CONFERENCE HALLS

The college has 3 air-conditioned conference halls equipped with multi-media projector, Smart TV, cordless mike, Wi-fi facility and seating capacity of 60 students for organizing conferences, seminars and group discussions.

CANTEEN

The college has a very spacious, hygienic and well designed canteen, where tasty and sumptuous refreshment as well as full meals are served.

SCIENCE LABS

The college has four well maintained science labs with latest equipments. Biology Labs (Botany & Zoology):- Specimen, permanent slides, microscopes Chemistry Lab: Laboratory glassware, heating mantle, pH meter, digital balance. Physics Lab: Spectrometer, p-n junction, transistors, photoelectric effect, oscillator, pendulum (Compound & Kater)

LANGUAGE LAB

The college has a well-maintained language lab where students are instructed in communication skills through several tutorials based on speaking, listening and reading. Language lab equips the students with interesting ways of learning. Unlike traditional learning methods, students get audio-visual aids for grasping good communication skills in an efficient manner. Teachers assist the students with explanation of subject modules and the Students actively perform various lab activities under the supervision of Teachers. By accessing language lab, students learn on practical basis. With the help of various resources such as Computers, headphones, internet services, projector and speakers etc., students enhance their vocabulary, accent along with skills such as listening, reading and speaking.





COMPUTER LABS

The college has four air-conditioned computer labs with 127 latest computers. Features:

- All labs are networked through structured cabling and dedicated IBM servers.
- Legal software through Microsoft Developer Academic Alliance (MSDN).
- Original software like Windows- 10, Oracle, MS Office. Professional Plus 2016, Visual Studio, C++, Windows Server 2000, Quick Heal total security, AVG Security etc.
- Laser printers for each lab.
- Latest equipments like multimedia projector and scanner, digital camera etc. are available for the students.

GYMNASIUM (INDOOR & OUTDOOR)

Keeping in view the physical fitness of hostlers, a well equipped air conditioned gymnasium has been set up within the campus.



HOME SCIENCE & Home Management

Home Management and Home Science is important for developing strong relationships between the individuals in a home and to know the techniques of an efficient home living.



RECREATION HALL

Recreation hall provides facilities like LCD and Indoor games (table tennis, carom board etc.), where students can get rid off psychological and emotional stress and we also arrange religious functions at that place.



TUCK SHOP

One tuck shop is available for the students within the campus. It has all the required material for the convenience of students. A colour printer has also been installed to facilitate students.





STUDENT SUPPORT SYSTEM

Since holistic personality development is the hallmark of SSDGC, therefore, the college provides ample opportunities to the students to participate in various co-curricular activities to enable them to express their talents and develop in them the qualities of courage, discipline, leadership, sportsmanship and team spirit.

N.C.C.

The N.C.C. unit of SSDGC offers considerable scope for stimulating discipline and adventure. The N.C.C. unit comes under 4 Pb. Girls BN NCC Patiala. Enrollment in N.C.C. depends upon physical fitness of the cadet for military training. A student can be an N.C.C. cadet for three years. During this period, students get ample opportunities to attend training camps and specialized camps like Advanced Leadership, Mountaineering and other inter-state camps. N.C.C. cadets are trained to qualify B and C certificate exams. Students holding 'C' certificate are given priority in selection as an officer in Army, Air Force, Navy and Police. Students holding 'B' and 'C' certificate are given incentives and additional weightage in higher classes for admission. Cadets are suitably awarded College Colour (N.C.C.), Best Cadet, Best in services by the college for excelling in N.C.C. activities.

ADMISSION

SSDGC scrupulously observe rules and regulations of the University in all matters.

ADMISSION RULES

- 1. Admission forms should be submitted in time.
- 2. No admission form will be entertained after the last date of admission prescribed by the university.
- 3. Parents must accompany their wards at the time of admission and interview.
- 4. A student whose result is declared late can seek admission within 20 working days after the declaration of result but in no case later than the last date announced by the university.
- 5. A candidate who has passed 10 + 2 examination or equivalent shall be eligible provided she has opted Punjabi as one of the subject of matriculation or any other equivalent examination. Those candidates who have not passed the subject of Punjabi up to matriculation level have to pass it, during the respective course, failing which their result will be withheld by the university. The college will not be held responsible for the non-declaration of the result by the university.
- 6. Candidate who has passed their matriculation examination from school/institutions situated outside the state of Punjab, may be allowed to take up the subject of Punjabi Compulsory (Mudhla Gyan) in lieu of Punjabi Compulsory.
- 7. Children of Defense/Paramilitary personnel (serving as well as retired) will be allowed to take up the subject of Punjabi Compulsory (Mudhla Gyan) provided that the father/ mother/guardian of the candidate gives an affidavit that the candidate has not studied Punjabi at school level.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING ADMISSION FORMS

- 1. Each application must be made on prescribed form attached with the prospectus available in the college office.
- 2. The application form must be filled in by the candidate in a clear and legible manner. The application form must be complete in all respects.
- 3. If any information sought is not applicable to the candidate, the word NA should be entered against that column. If a candidate omits/conceals relevant information or gives false information, her admission is liable to be cancelled.
- 4. Anti-ragging form must be filled at the time of admission.
- 5. Undertaking for detention due to lack of 75% attendance must be filled by parents & students.

CERTIFICATES AND DOCUMENTS REQUIRED ALONG WITH THE ADMISSION FORM

- 1. Four Recent passport size photographs.
- 2. Character certificate duly attested by the head of the institution last attended.
- 3. The original and attested photocopies of mark sheet of last Board/University examination passed.

- Eligibility Certificate, by the students who have passed the lower examination from Board/University other than Punjab School Education Board, state board of Haryana, Himachal Pardesh, C.B.S.E. and I.C.S.E. from Registration branch of Punjabi University, Patiala.

COLLEGE RULES

- It is mandatory for a student to attend at least 75% of lectures delivered in each subject in order to be eligible for university examinations.
- In case of serious illness of a candidate, relaxation in percentage shall be 6% i.e. 69% shall be compulsory.
- Medical leave should be supported with medical certificate (issued by Senior Medical Officer of govt. hospital/dispensary) and should be submitted in the college office on the 2nd day of illness.
- Student's leave application should be submitted in the college office well before availing the leave. It should be signed by the parents/guardian/hostel warden (in case of hostellers) and should be recommended by the concerned tutorial incharge.
- Disciplinary action will be taken against the students who skip classes.
- Students owning vehicles must wear helmets.
- Day scholars are not allowed to leave the college campus before 1:10 p.m. In case of emergency, permission is to be sought from the Principal based on written request from the parents.
- After the Mid Semester Test, a Parent-Teacher Meeting is held which is obligatory and mandatory for the parents to attend, otherwise a heavy fine will be imposed.
- Students should not damage any property of the college.
- Students should get their library cards issued from library at the beginning of session.
- Loss of library card should be immediately reported in writing to the librarian who may issue a duplicate card on payment of Rs. 50. No student can have two cards at a time. A new card can be issued from the library when the previous card is exhausted.

EXAMINATION

- Only those students will be allowed to appear in university examination who have passed the MSTs.
